



APSC Enforcement Inspector: Vehicular Population Growth

The transport demand in India has been growing rapidly. Sustained economic growth, improved road infrastructure and increased disposable income of households have led to the rising demand for road transport.

There has been a continuous increase in the number of registered motor vehicles in India since 1951. The total number of registered motor vehicles increased from about 0.3 million in March, 1951 to 230.03 million up to 31st March, 2016 .

The total registered vehicles in the country grew at a Compound Annual Growth Rate (CAGR) of 9.9 per cent between 2006 and 2016
