



Subject-wise distribution

- **Environment, Forestry & Wildlife** (Q1-4, 23-24, 30-31, 36, 39, 63, 66-68): ~15 questions — heaviest theme. Covers National Parks/Sanctuaries law, Project Cheetah, biodiversity hotspots, conservation agriculture, endangered species (pygmy hog), carbon sequestration, zero tillage, H5N1.
- **Assam-specific GK** (Q7-9, 17, 24, 33, 43, 47-49, 53, 56, 58, 71, 73-74, 82, 89): ~18 questions — Ahom history, tribal languages, state symbols, schemes, tea estates, literary sources.
- **Modern Indian History & Freedom Movement** (Q4-6, 17, 19, 70, 73): Provisional governments, Raja Ram Mohan Roy, Vimukti Divas, Gandhi's hunger strikes, Dandi March.
- **Polity & Governance** (Q25-26, 29, 64, 90-91): Panchayats Act, Article 371F, Collegium System, NCW, Constitutional amendments.
- **Science & Environment (applied)** (Q2, 21-22, 45, 50, 52, 66-68, 83, 86, 88, 92, 96): Pollutants, cloudburst definition, chemical changes, Epsom salt, BrahMos, Big Bang theory, Turing test.
- **Current Affairs (2024-26, heavy weightage)** (Q10-13, 33, 37, 44, 46, 55, 60, 62, 79-81, 84-85, 89): ~18 questions — very recent: PMMSY clusters, Whitley Award, Olympic emblem designer, SwaRail app, Sahitya Akademi, Budget schemes, Crafoord Prize, BHIM UPI, BrahMos.
- **Quantitative Aptitude/Reasoning** (Q15-16, 40-42, 76-78, 97-98): ~10 questions — speed-distance-time, sets, sequences, averages, algebra, trigonometry, work-time, percentages.
- **English (Vocabulary)** (Q51, 59): Synonym/antonym — small but present.
- **General Science (Physics/Chem/Bio basics)** (Q50, 52, 83, 86-88, 92): Chemical changes, metal properties, planets, Epsom salt, rice variety.
- **Sports & Miscellaneous GK** (Q44, 54, 62, 93-94, 99): Football rankings, chess

Key trends

1. **Environment/Forestry theme is deliberately foregrounded** — reflects the Forest Ranger post specifically
2. **Assam-specific content remains strong (~18%)**
3. **Current affairs cutoff is very recent** (Budget 2026-27, Crafoord Prize 2026, SDG count, SwaRail app) — paper finalized close to test date
