It is known as the Ghaggar in India and becomes the Hakra in Pakistan.

The charter contains seventy-six verses in Sanskrit and features a ladle-shaped royal seal with a front-facing elephant. The plates are permanently housed at the Assam State Museum in Guwahati

He managed to assemble a massive combined army consisting of roughly 400,000 soldiers. However, his ambitious expansion campaign never materialized, as Rudra Singha suddenly fell ill and passed away in Guwahati in August 1714 before the invasion could begin.
