



Asmita Rugby League is gearing up for its next tournament, scheduled to be held on November 9 and 10, 2024 at Goreswar Higher Secondary School in Tamulpur, Assam. Organised under the Khelo India initiative, this event aims to promote women's participation in sports, with 288 athletes from 24 teams competing across Under 15, Under 18, and Senior categories.
