



Glaw Lake in **Arunachal Pradesh** has been designated as **India's 101st Ramsar Site**, becoming the **first wetland in the State** to receive international recognition under the **Ramsar Convention**. The lake is **located within the Kamlang Tiger Reserve and Wildlife Sanctuary**, underscoring its rich ecological significance.
