



Jagun Attack — UXO Threat and Response

A standoff attack was reported near an Assam Police Commando camp at Jagun in Tinsukia district, where unexploded ordnance such as RPG and UBGL rounds were found, posing serious risks to civilians. The Indian Army promptly carried out operations to safely neutralise these explosives.

Unexploded ordnance (UXO) refers to munitions like bombs, shells or grenades that fail to detonate on impact and remain hazardous for long periods. Their presence highlights ongoing internal security challenges and the need for swift disposal to ensure public safety.
