



KCP (PWG) Cadres Surrender in Manipur

Forty-six cadres of the **Kangleipak Communist Party (People's War Group)** surrendered and laid down arms, marking a step towards peace and stability in **Manipur**. The outfit is a banned Maoist separatist group seeking Manipur's secession from India.

Founded in **1980**, the KCP has splintered into several factions over ideological differences. The name **Kangleipak** refers to the ancient name of Manipur, with **Kangla** serving as its historic capital for centuries.
