



Keyi Panyor – India's First Bio-Happy District

Keyi Panyor was showcased as India's first "*Bio-Happy District*" during the inauguration of the *Arunachal Pradesh Jaiv Vividhata and Mvm Liid Soonam/Beej Utsav 2026* at Yazali.

The two-day festival focused on biodiversity conservation, climate resilience and the concept of *biohappiness*, which emphasises human well-being through harmony with nature, sustainable livelihoods and protection of ecological resources.
