



Khamniungan Tribe and SCERT Nagaland Apology

State Council of Educational Research and Training Nagaland issued an apology after a spelling error in the name of the *Khamniungan Tribe* appeared in a Class 8 textbook.

The Khamniungan are a major transboundary Naga community inhabiting Noklak and Tuensang districts of Nagaland and parts of Myanmar's Sagaing Region. Their important festivals include *Tsokum*, a post-harvest celebration marked by feasting, dances and community activities, and *Miu*, observed during the sowing season for agricultural prosperity.
