



- **Lamsial Puk**, located near **Farkawn village** in **Champhai district, Mizoram**, is one of the state's most significant archaeological sites.
- **Radiocarbon (Carbon-14) dating** of ancient human skeletal remains recovered from the cave has dated them to **AD 1729-1789**, providing one of the first scientifically verified dates for human remains discovered at the site.
- The findings enhance understanding of **Mizoram's archaeological heritage** and the region's historical human occupation.
