Key Data: In 2024, 76,020 people died alone at home in Japan; 76.4% were aged 65 or older.

First Official Record: This is the first time Japan has compiled such data, as per the National Police Agency.

Government Response: Data will guide new policies to combat loneliness and social isolation.

Kodokushi: A long-standing social issue in Japan, referring to elderly individuals dying alone and remaining undiscovered for long periods.

Significance: Highlights aging population challenges and the need for social welfare reforms.
