



New Microsnail Species Discovered in Meghalaya

Scientists exploring limestone cave systems in the Khasi Hills of Meghalaya discovered two new microsnail species — *Georissa meghalayaensis* and *Acmella bensoni*.

The species were found in *Krem Puri* and *Arwah Cave*. The discovery highlights the rich but understudied biodiversity of Northeast India. Researchers also reported the first record of *Georissa* from Mizoram and additional records from Manipur, expanding the known distribution of the genus.
