



Northeast Indian Paddy Frog: Southernmost Record

A tiny frog recorded in **Dampa Tiger Reserve, Mizoram**, has extended the known range of the Northeast Indian Paddy Frog (*Micryletta aishani*). The discovery represents the species' **southernmost documented occurrence**, adding an important new location to its known distribution.

The Dampa population was found approximately **147 km south of the type locality at Subhong, Assam**, and about **23 km southwest of its previously known Mizoram record at Sihhmui, Aizawl district**. The study also provides the **first documented information on the species' diet**.
