



Pulitzer Recognition for Indian Journalists

Anand R.K., Suparna Sharma and Natalie Obiko Pearson received the Pulitzer Prize in the Illustrated Reporting and Commentary category for their Bloomberg project *“trAPPed.”* The work exposed the human impact of cybercrime, including cases of “digital arrest” used to defraud victims.

Separately, Aniruddha Ghosal was part of a team honoured in the International Reporting category. These recognitions highlight India-linked journalism addressing emerging digital threats.
