



Spring Mapping and Revival Plan in Manipur

Environment / Water Resources / Climate Adaptation

The Directorate of Environment and Climate Change (DoECC) in Manipur has mapped over **1,000 springs** across the State. Of these, **173 critical springs** in **Ukhrul and Noney districts** have been prioritised for revival under a dedicated scheme, recognising their role in drinking water security and ecosystem health.

The department has also released an **environment calendar** as part of its information and awareness programme on key environmental events and observances at the State, national, and global levels. The first such calendar was launched in 2013.
