Which of the following sequences or statements concerning tributaries of the Brahmaputra in Assam is/are not correct?

- (i) The North bank tributaries (from West to East): Sankosh, Manas, Puthimari, Pagladiya
- (ii) The South bank tributaries (from East to West): Buri Dihing, Bhogdoi, Dhansiri, Kopili
- (iii) The North bank tributaries (from East to West): Jiadhal, Subansiri, Ranganadi, Jia Bharali
- (iv) The River Barnadi forms a natural boundary between Darrang and Kamrup districts.

- (B) (i) and (ii) only
- (C) (ii) and (iv) only
- (D) (i), (ii) and (iii) only

(i) North bank tributaries (West to East): Sankosh, Manas, Puthimari, Pagladiya

Incorrect

The correct West to East order of north bank tributaries is:

Sankosh → Raidak → Manas → Beki → Puthimari → Pagladiya → Barnadi → Subansiri →
Ranganadi → Jia Bharali

The mistake:



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Puthimari comes after Pagladiya, not before. Hence, the order is wrong.
